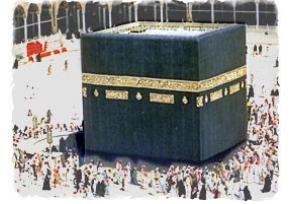


The Kabah is My Qiblah

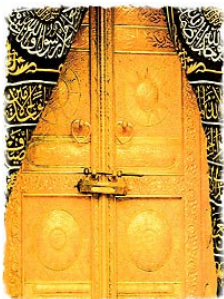
